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### **Recommendation(s)**

That Council receive and consider the City of Mission 2022 Annual Report, including audited financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2022.

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this report is to present the 2022 Annual Report to Council, at a public meeting for consideration in accordance with Section 98 of the *Community Charter*.

### **Background**

In accordance with Section 98 of the *Community Charter*, Council is required to consider the City's Annual Report at a public meeting, each year. Due to the size of the Annual Report, it was distributed separately and posted to the City's website.

The City's 2022 Annual Report includes the following information:

1. Audited 2022 financial statements;
2. Details of permissive tax exemptions and community grants provided by Council;
3. Details regarding municipal services and operations for the 2022 calendar year;
4. Performance measures and achievements related to Council's goals and objectives; and
5. Information of interest, such as departmental overviews, and statistical information on taxation, assessment and development.

The highlights of the City's financial position and results are noted in the "Report from the Director of Finance" within the Annual Report (page 34). On May 1, 2023, the City Auditor's Report was received by Council and the 2022 Financial Statements were approved.

Staff will once again be submitting the annual report to the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for consideration for the Canadian Award for Financial Reporting Achievement award.
