## Proclamation

City of Mission Council Resolution - June 2, 2025

- WHEREAS** the City Council acknowledges the historical injustices endured by Indigenous peoples through colonial policies, including the Sixties Scoop, Millennium Scoop, birth alerts, and other practices that disrupted Indigenous families and communities; and
- WHEREAS** Indigenous Survivors Day on June 30th, 2025 provides an opportunity to honor the resilience, strength, and cultural heritage of Indigenous communities who have persevered through family separation, forced assimilation, and systemic discrimination; and
- WHEREAS** this observance creates a platform for healing, education, and dialogue, raising awareness of Indigenous challenges and celebrating resilience; and
- WHEREAS** by implementing Indigenous Survivors Day on June 30th, 2025, the City Council affirms its commitment to honoring Indigenous survivors, promoting healing, and fostering an inclusive and equitable community.

Be it resolved that the City of Mission hereby proclaims June 30th, 2025 as

**“Indigenous Survivors Day”**
