NOTICE TO RESIDENTS
Falcon Sanitary Pump Station Upgrade
Falcon Crescent Cul-de-Sac Improvements

The District of Mission is upgrading the sanitary sewer pump station located at 7841 Falcon Crescent. As part of the project, the pump station will be moved to the centre of the cul-de-sac to correct a private property encroachment issue. As such, the cul-de-sac will be reconfigured to achieve the following goals:

- Accommodate safe traffic movements including tandem axle trucks (garbage trucks, snow plows, etc.).
- Provide a practical and cost-effective option to relocate the pump station which can facilitate maintenance and operation.
- Retain residential parking wherever possible.

A plan of the proposed reconfiguration is attached for your reference.

This information would typically be delivered to you in an open house format but unfortunately due to COVID19, our public consultation on this matter will be different and I kindly ask for your patience and understanding.

In an effort to comply with Public Health requirements and ensure that you receive an opportunity to comment on this project, the follow procedure will be carried out:
