Key, Acting Director of Parks, Recreation and Culture will be the City liaison with UFV along with a representative from the Mission Downtown Business Association.

c) Komagata Maru Tragedy

The Chair for the Mission Heritage Commission, K. Hood, emailed the Commission requesting that a member from the CRC join a discussion panel being put together to establish a memorial/story board for the Komagata Maru Tragedy.
