Re: Campaign Sign Restrictions

Dear Mayor and Council:

I understand the City of Mission is reviewing bylaws regarding campaign signs and considering further restrictions for signs during federal, provincial and municipal elections. While some limits are necessary to ensure our roads are safe and the view of drivers' is not impeded, other limits on campaign advertising risk undue negative impacts on our democratic processes.

Campaign advertising is a fundamental tool for election candidates in ensuring their message is heard. It is also a measure to encourage greater voter turnout and participation in elections. City bylaws on the number, size and placement of signs could directly interfere with candidates' campaign strategies, visibility to the community, and ultimately how residents will choose to vote.
